

CLINIC DOCTOR

The responsibilities of the Clinic Doctor include:

- Providing medical checks for service users in the clinic setting
- Providing information on appropriate services the service user should access
- Completing medical forms for our clinic to abide by Healthcare Commission regulations
- Raising awareness amongst service users on the importance of maintaining their health
- Educating service users on maintaining good physical or mental health until they access mainstream services
- Prescribing appropriate medication for service users, if required
- Advocating on behalf of service users to fellow medical professionals in the NHS

Qualifications and qualities required to volunteer as a Clinic Doctor include:

- Full registration with the General Medical Council to practice medicine in the UK
- Needs to be on GP register
- Medical Indemnity Insurance Cover which includes working in *Doctors of the World's* clinic
- Confident working with interpreting services
- Non-judgmental behaviour or attitude towards our service users and confidence in working with service users from diverse backgrounds
- Fluency in English
